



Ryder Cup Ticket Process for PGAs of Europe Members

As part of the Member Benefit Scheme for PGAs of Europe Members, The PGAs of Europe is pleased to announce details for the application process to obtain Ryder Cup tickets for the matches to be held at The Celtic Manor Resort, City of Newport, Wales on 1st to 3rd October 2010.

Application forms will be available in January 2010 and no applications will be accepted prior to that date. PGA Members will be entitled to a free ticket plus one half price ticket for a guest. There are 2000 tickets available under this scheme for members of The PGA of GB & I, The European Tour and PGAs of Europe member countries. Tickets are on a first come first served basis. Guests must attend the same day/s as the PGA Member; however, the named guest can vary from day to day. Tickets acquired under this concession include free car park access in the designated area. Tickets are to be collected on a daily basis during the week of the matches at a location to be advised.

There will be no access to the matches as a PGA member unless a ticket is acquired under this system. There will be no admittance by, or entitlement to, a ticket by just appearing at the matches with a PGA Member card.

Credit or debit card details will be taken with the application for tickets to cover amounts due for half price guest tickets; however, payment will not be processed until June 2010. Tickets are non refundable after your payment has been taken.

At previous Ryder Cup matches large numbers of tickets were ordered by PGA Members but not collected and to prevent this happening at the matches in 2010, The PGAs of Europe and Ryder Cup reserve the right to charge at full price for any tickets applied for under this concession and not used. Members may be depriving other members of access to the matches by applying for tickets and not attending.

As part of this Member benefit package the PGA Members unit will provide a private area to view the golf on television and purchase food and beverages for you and your guest.
